| Walk | Location | Length | Description | Facilities |

| Dularcha National Park | <p>From Landsborough: entrance in Beech Road off Myla Road, about 2.5 km north of railway station</p> <p>From Mooloolah: entrance is 800 m from station along Paget Street, off Jones St.</p> | Return walk is 6.4 km, allow 2 hours. | Track is reasonably level but somewhat rough in places. It traverses a 70 m-long old railway tunnel, the interior of which is quite black - torch may be handy. Reasonable fitness required. | Nil on walk but at either end are shops and services of the towns. |
| Ewen Maddock Dam | On Mooloolah Connection road, 1.8 km north of junction with Glass House Mountains Road. Entry to carpark is 200m past Mooloolah Country Club. | <p>a) Spillway Walk, 1.5 km return, allow 45 minutes.</p> <p>b) Dam Walk, 5 km return, allow 2 hours.</p> | <p>a) Flat and open, low fitness required.</p> <p>b) Through undulating open eucalypt forest with some steep sections, moderate fitness required.</p> | Toilets, picnic areas, BBQs, swimming. |
| Jowarra State Forest | Glass House Mountains Road adjacent to Rustic Cabin Restaurant. | Circuit of 1.7 km with several interconnecting sidetracks, allow 1 hour. | Mostly flat through rainforest and wet sclerophyll. Low to moderate fitness required. | Toilets, picnic areas, wheelchair access. |
